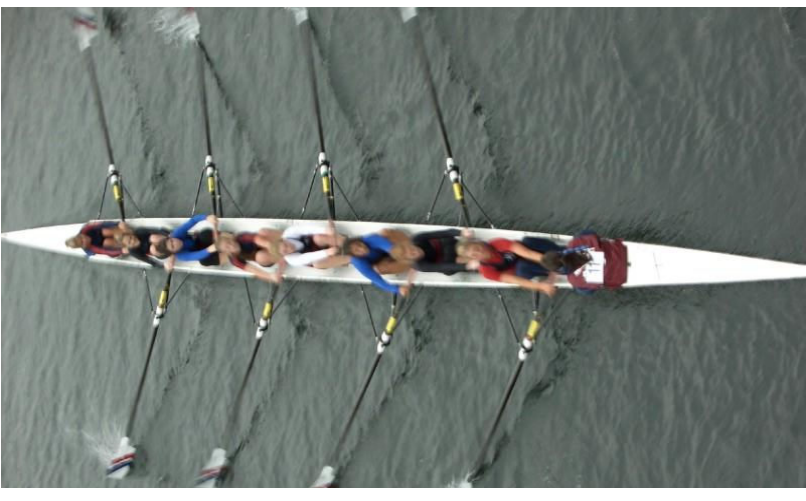

Commencement Bay Rowing Club

Founded in 1992, CBRC started with a single four-oared shell. In 1997, our 12,000 square foot boathouse (one of the largest in the Northwest) was built on land leased from the City Lakewood at Harry Todd Park.

The CBRC boathouse has four active boat bays. The boathouse is home to crews from PLU, UPS and a masters team.

American Lake is a beautiful rowing venue. The lake boasts miles of undeveloped shoreline and protected no-wake zones. CBRC has three launching docks custom made for rowing shells.



Summer Learn To Row Program

The Summer Program is offered to 8th through 12th grade students. No equipment or experience is necessary

CBRC Junior Rowing

The Junior Rowing Program has included athletes from 24 high schools in Pierce, Thurston, Kitsap and King Counties. **In 2009 two crews from CBRC won entries at the Junior National Regatta in Cincinnati, Ohio!** CBRC has had representatives on the Junior National Team, and many of our rowers continue to row for college programs throughout the United States.
